The idea was born to build a safe haven where groups of missionaries could stay while working in Haiti.



By the 1980s, the group had constructed many churches, schools and canteens. But in 2010, disaster struck. The earthquake in Port au Prince caused destruction beyond repair to the FOHO compound.


PROJECTS IN NEED OF COMPLETION
